

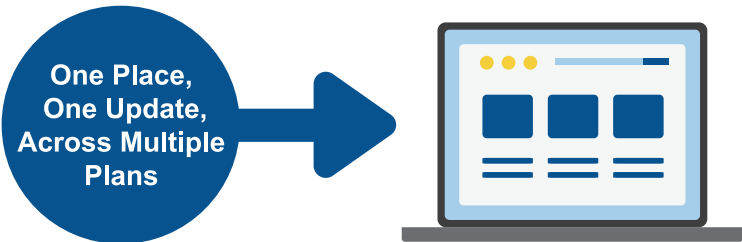
CMS Qualified Health Plan (QHP) Directory Pilot with Oklahoma



Join Oklahoma's Effort to Improve Provider Data

Oklahoma is leading the way

CMS and the Oklahoma Insurance Department launched the QHP Directory Pilot to improve provider data accuracy and lower administrative burden. The pilot lets providers review and verify prepopulated directory information in a single, centralized portal.



Why participate?

Lower Administrative Burden
Avoid updating information across multiple health plans and systems.

Save Time
Use one centralized portal to manage directory information.

Improve Data Accuracy
Help ensure patients and health plans have accurate provider information.

Prepare for the Future
Strengthen your readiness if there is a national directory requirement in the future.

20 payers (and plans) updated per provider on average.

67% of physicians want one system to manage directory information.

Time is running out to participate

1**LOG IN**

Use National Plan & Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) credentials to access the QHP Directory Portal.

2**REVIEW & VERIFY**

Review, update, and verify your information now

- Contact Information
- Demographics
- Professional Profile
- Practice Locations

3**REPORT CHANGES WITHIN 30 DAYS**

Make updates if there are changes
Confirm information is accurate and submit updates within 30 days.

4**REVERIFY EVERY 90 DAYS**

Be compliant with No Surprises Act (NSA)
Be audit ready! Make sure this information is current: practice location, contact information, specialty or credentials, health plan network status, facility or organization information.

5**SHARE FEEDBACK**

Provide feedback to CMS about the portal experience.

What's next?

Verify your information so:

Participating health plans have the most up-to-date information to use in their own provider directories.

Provider directories become more accurate.



Secure environment:
This portal is for professional use, available only to authorized users, and isn't viewable by the public.
Note: Data may be used by issuers to populate their consumer-facing directories.
